Forty acre agricultural farm land next to Battleswick Farm, Rowhedge

Dear Sirs,

I understand that a housing development is proposed for this important site. I wish to strongly object to the proposal. First, it is good agricultural land.

It forms a strategic barrier between Colchester TOWN and Rowhedge VILLAGE.

Rowhedge is about to absorb a very large development on the other side of the village. ONE such development for a village is more than enough.

The infrastructure is inadequate, particularly for sewerage where it is clear that the system is already straining to cope, and with the terrible smells at peak periods still not cured Much of the road access is via St Botolphs roundabout which already suffers major congestion at peak periods, and we have yet to see how it copes when the new barracks development is complete.

It is important to keep Rowhedge village as a separate entity from Colchester town
