We moved here 4/5 years ago, to be away from an area which became vastly overdeveloped and caused so many problems. It became horrendous to live there.

Green Spaces where our children played and we could walk our dogs, just disappeared under Concrete & Bricks. The roads were infested with parked cars & lorries etc. Schools became overcrowded. Roads flooded because not enough Drainage was added to existing systems.

Sewage Pipework under Roads kept breaking down eventually affecting houses & properties all over the whole area.

The Infrastructure of the whole area became a Total Debacle from which we managed to escape! But not before peoples Health & Wellbeing were being destroyed.

We are not "Rembys" just very concerned for all the Population of our "Green and Pleasant Land".

Council Taxes had to be Raised to cope, which was not very popular! But still building continued; although the Population of the area grew to enormous proportions we had no Hospital other than the 10 to 12 miles away.

Here we only have one Road to Colchester! where we lived we had to two Roads - but even so it could take over an hour to get

to the nearest Hospital! Traffic congestion all over the area created so much trouble. Air Ambulance had to be used on several occasions!

We feel the only thing to build in this area would be some small Bungalows, for some of the Elderly People if they wanted to downsize, some could perhaps be like Alms houses or even Council Properties run by Housing Associations. But just not great big Estates. We do not have the necessary Infrastructure to cope. Please try to leave as much Green & Wooded Areas for the good of Peoples Health & Well-Being.
