

- Statistics from the 2001 Census indicate that 14.62% of Colchester's population are migrants.
- This is higher than Essex (10.71%), the East (11.58%) and England (12.24%). Such high statistics could be attributed to the students from Essex University, in Colchester Borough, who would be included in this figure.
- Only a very small percentage of Colchester's population have had no usual address one year before the Census took place on 29th April 2001.
- Data also showed that 7.46% of the population migrated within the Colchester area at this time.
- Of those people in ethnic groups other than 'White', 9.99% moved into the Colchester area from within the UK.
- A further 7.82% moved to Colchester from outside the UK. This is the highest percentage in the Essex district and is also higher than the regional and national averages (East 3.61%, England 2.49%).
