Indices of Multiple Deprivation 2010 (from "The English Indices of Deprivation 2010" by Department for Communities and Local Government) (N.B. Where possible the indicators used in this release relate to 2008)

Income deprivation: This domain measures the proportion of the population in an area experiencing deprivation related to low income. In addition, two supplementary indices concerning income deprivation are also produced, an Income Deprivation Affecting Children Index (IDACI) and an Income Deprivation Affecting Older People Index (IDAOPI). These represent the proportion of children aged 0-15 living in income deprived households and the proportion of older people aged 60 and over living in income deprived households respectively.

Employment deprivation: This domain measures employment deprivation in an area conceptualised as involuntary exclusion of the working age population from the labour market.

Living Environment: This domain measures the quality of individuals' immediate surroundings both within and outside the home. The indicators fall into two sub-domains: the 'indoors' living environment, which measures the quality of housing, and the 'outdoors' living environment which contains two measures relating to air quality and road traffic accidents.

Crime: This domain measures the rate of recorded crime for four major crime types representing the risk of personal and material victimisation at a small area level. These are violence, burglary, theft and criminal damage.

Housing: This domain measures the physical and financial accessibility of housing and key local services. The indicators fall into 'geographical barriers', which relate to the physical proximity of local services, and 'wider' barriers which includes issues relating to access to housing such as affordability.

Health: This domain measures premature death and the impairment of quality of life by poor health. It considers both physical and mental health. The domain measures morbidity, disability and premature mortality but not aspects of behaviour or environment that may be predictive of future health deprivation.

Education: This domain measures the extent of deprivation in terms of education, skills and training in an area. The indicators are structured into two sub-domains: one relating to children and young people and one relating to adult skills. These sub-domains are designed to reflect the 'flow' and 'stock' of educational disadvantage within an area respectively.

Multiple deprivation: Each of these domains was constructed separately and each LSOA assigned a score and rank for that domain. The ranks were then transformed and combined to create the Overall Index of Multiple Deprivation.

^{*} LSOA - Lower Super Output Areas: homogenous small areas of relatively even size (around 1500 people) of which there are 32,482 in England. In all of the indices 1 is the most deprived and 32482 the least deprived LSOA in England.



However, the figures shown here use tax credit data to give the percentage of children on low incomes in local authorities, parliamentary constituencies and wards across the United Kingdom. Based on how many families are out of work or on low working incomes, this is not a direct measure of exactly how many children are in poverty on the official definition, but is the closest measure we have of local levels of child poverty. The figures are estimates for mid-2011.

In the figures presented above, children are classified as being in poverty if they live in families in receipt of out of work benefits or in receipt of in-work tax credits where their reported income is less than 60 per cent of median income. The number of children in poverty on this measure is reported by HMRC for 2009. We have used survey data to estimate change between 2009 and 2011."







The predicted number of older people with care needs 2010-20.. Unitary Authority/District








Essex Insight Recorded Violent Crime - recorded violent crime per 1000 pop... Unitary Authority/District




