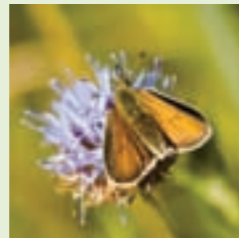


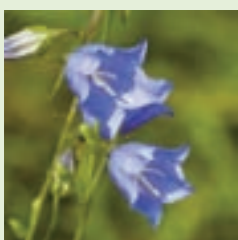
Deer

Butterflies such as essex skipper, white admiral and speckled wood are found during the summer in sunny clearings in the woods on thistle, honeysuckle and other plants

The park's woods are well known for their spring displays of bluebells



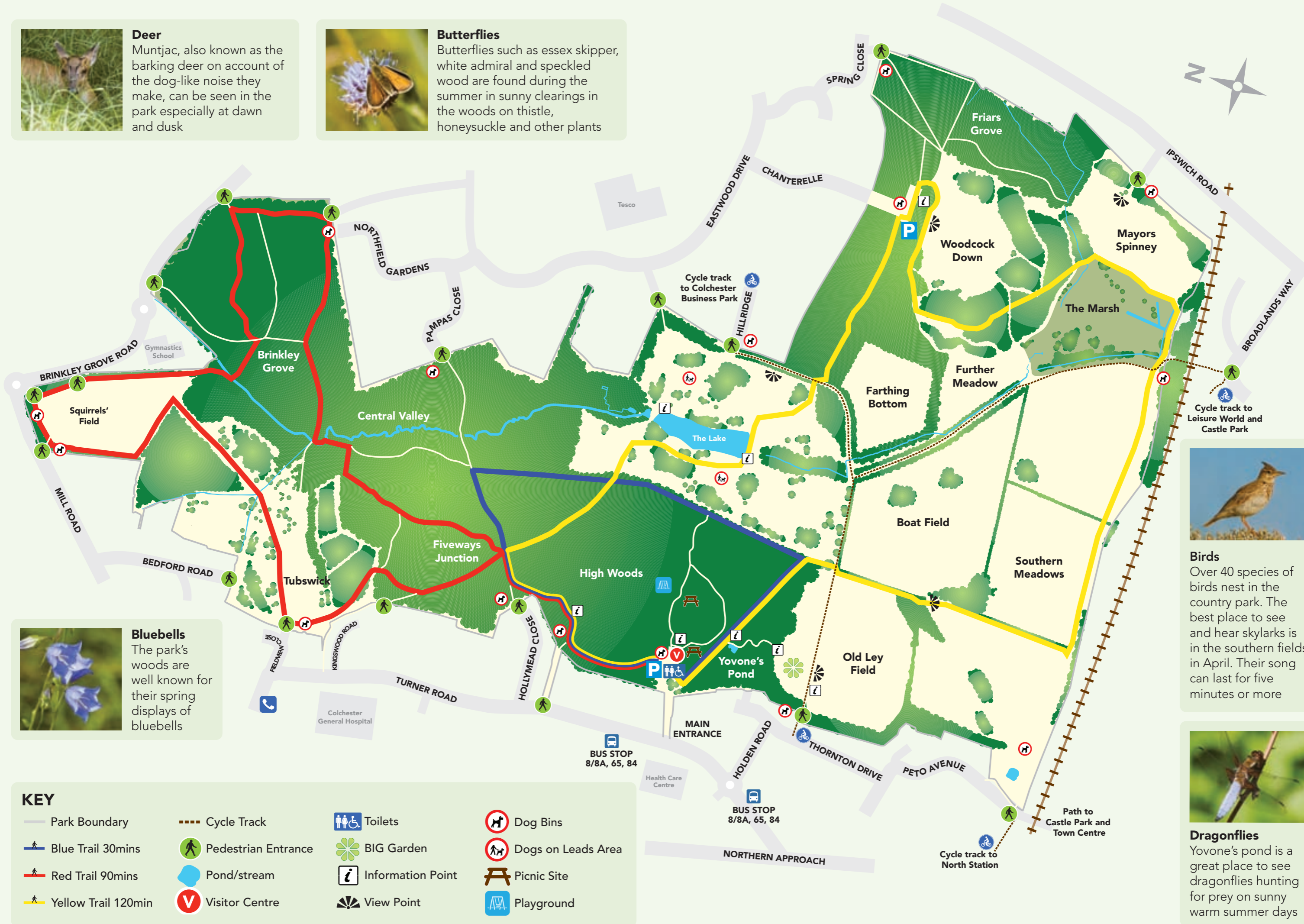
Birds
