Representation 6182 — Whilst the Council have a register set up on their web site, there is no evidence of any availability of any self-build plots in the Borough. I think this is a political sop. I have made several applications on land that I own in Lexden to construct a bungalow for retirement and have been faced by objection from the Council and no willingness to act positively/proactively to achieve a legitimate planning consent.

• Do policies DM8 to DM11 provide a clear direction as to how a decision maker should react to a development proposal?

As above the policies in DM10 are words not actions. I see nothing in the plan to give positive meaningful support to self-build housing development. This is particularly evident in the Councils attitude towards elderly persons accommodation in sustainable locations. I would like to know why the Council continue to go out of their way to frustrate rather than facilitate self-build housing development?.
