Colchester Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2019-A

Statement of Reasons

The Borough Council in exercise of their powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intends to make a permanent Order which relates to the following Parking Places:

Colchester: Sheepen Road Lorry and Coach Park, Vineyard Street, Priory Street, Britannia, Sheepen Road, Middleborough, Town Hall car park, Osbourne Street Surface car park, Napier Road North, Napier Road South, St. John's, St. Mary's, Prettygate Road, St. Christopher Road, Butt Road, Old Heath Road, The Recreation Ground at Port Lane, Leisure World, Leisure World B car park, St. Julian Grove, Town Hall car park, Bus Station, Alexandra Terrace, Walsingham Road, Bergholt Road, Three Crowns Road, Osbourne Street car park, Sanderson Mews, West Stockwell, Stockwell, Ken Cooke Court Area A & Area B resident parking areas. **Myland:** High Woods Country Park. **Lexden:** London Road car park. **Dedham:** Mill Lane car and lorry park & Mill Pond car park. **West Mersea:** Victoria Esplanade, Willoughby Park, Seaview Avenue, Coast Road, Town Hard surface area & High Street car parks. **Wivenhoe:** Cooks Yard A car park, Cooks Yard B car park and High Street car park.

Town Hard Surface Area

This area needs to be kept clear of motor vehicles to allow boats to launch. By adding the area into the Off-street car park order patrolling and if necessary, enforcement of the area will be able to take place to ensure that the Town Hard is kept clear of vehicles.

Loveurcar permits

The Loveurcar car share permit scheme has been in operation for a number of years. The articles to the order are now being altered to include Loveurcar permits and so allow enforcement action to be taken if the conditions of parking in the Loveurcar bays are not complied with. No physical changes will be made to the Loveurcar permit spaces that are already in place.

Dedham Mill Lane Car Park Permits

The terms and conditions of these permits are being added to the Order.

Technical Change to number 3.13 of the Order

This section is being altered to include virtual payments as in most car parks an alternative to paying at pay and display machines is usually available.
