Photograph 1: View (looking west) along the line of the southern *cavea* (not demarcated) in EX905194 (Abacus Land 4 Ltd), June 2020. Pearce Court and Bradman Court are located on the left (south) behind the mature trees.



Photograph 2: View (looking west) of the D-shaped lawn EX787918 (Taylor Wimpey), January 2019. The low bank is immediately behind the railings. The reconstructed stumps of the starting gates are located in front of the blue hoarding and the Former Officers' Quarters (NHLE no. 1375581) is behind it.
