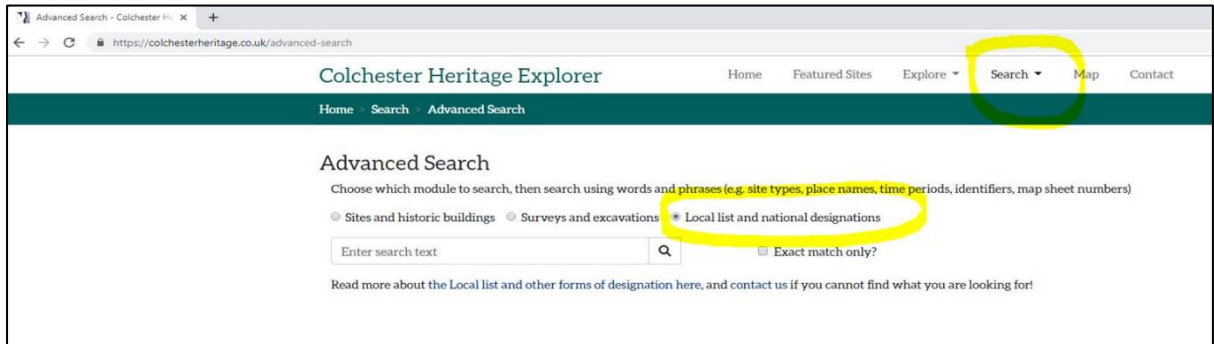


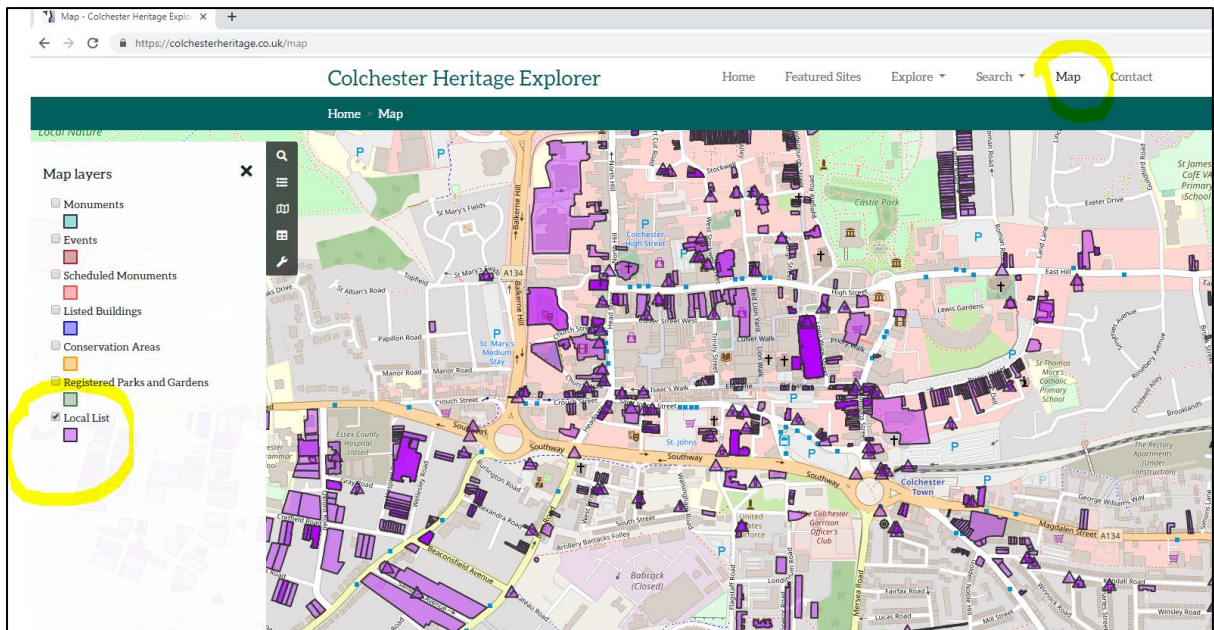
## How to find heritage assets on the Colchester Local List

The Local List can be accessed in two ways:

1. Using the advanced search tab and typing a search in the box. Please remember to make sure the 'Local List and national designations' is ticked (see below, highlighted in yellow).



2. Or, using the interactive map tab. Please remember to make sure the Local List is ticked, to display this layer (other datasets can be interrogated in a similar way, if they are ticked).



Click on polygon on the map and it will display the record (this is a dynamic link to the Historic Environment Record):



The individual record will then be display (in this case the tram shed on Military Road):

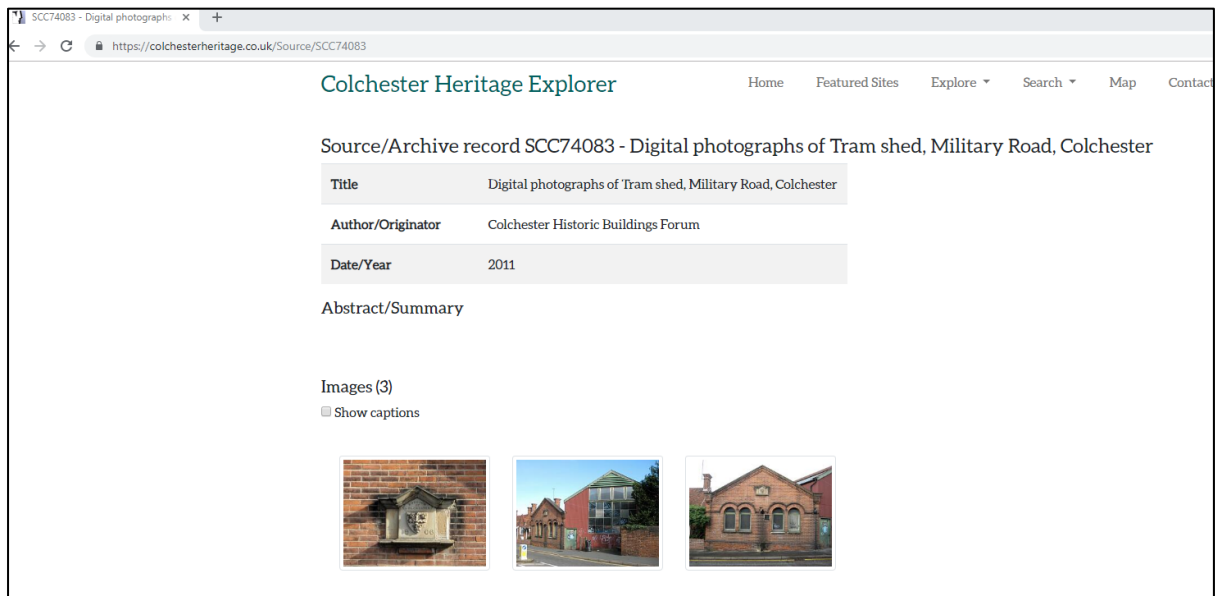
