- Update on additional funding (conversations)
 - No wider funding likely to be secured until after 14 June (deadline to confirm projects & spend profiles to MHCLG)
- Potential funding opportunities outside timeline for initial project plan to MHCLG (14 June) include:
 - Homes England Investment Partner
 - North Essex National Home Building Fund
 - Health partners
 - Other capital programmes
- Formally asked MHCLG whether we can submit the 14 June return, retaining all projects whilst we carry on seeking wider funding
- Other capital funding sources and clarification on above funding? (Question to Board)



- Approach for Board to agree:
- Keep all projects in the 'We are Colchester' programme to reflect longer term vision
- Phasing / prioritising projects eg. some to be delivered beyond the end of the 2025/26 spend window for Town Deal award
- Continue to scan / apply for future funding opportunities
- Programme team will bring back phased approach to Board late May for sign off
