


1. Introduction












Detail of St Botolph's scheme (after intervention):

Heritage walk: 1) new exit steps/ramp from station platform directly to 2) the newly created Britannia Yard:




3) onwards through the Priory Gardens, then 4) crossing Priory Street, leading to:
