### **Progress highlights**

- Jumbo (HLF bid and Balkerne Gate synergies),
- Holy Trinity Church (repairs underway, HLF EOI, architect appointment),
- Holy Trinity Square (public consultation),
- Essex County Hospital (contractor appointment and on site works start),
- Greenstead Tamarisk Way (architect appointment for community hub and site masterplan),
- Essex Pedal Power (resident sign up and planned bike handout),
- Liveable Neighbourhood (engagement on early design options),
- Digital Skills Hub (on site works due to complete August),
- Digital Working Hub Queen Street (out to tender, contractor appointment soon),
- 5G (telco consultation re co-funding options, tourism VR content design starting July/August),
- Transformed Youth Facilities (contractor award due, on site works Stanway/Highwoods youth centres July/August and Townhouse from September),
- Walking and Cycling LCWIP4 (Colne Causeway to Uni tender expected back soon, Haddon Park/Hythe Station Bridge at feasibility stage, improvement to materials planned for City Centre sections close to listed buildings).

### Delivery, Time, Cost RAG headlines

#### Programme RAG status – AMBER

**Overall** – good progress across programme; issues and risks (Highways and Lion Walk permissions (public realm – eg. St Nicholas Square), land ownership (Greenstead), cost escalation (general, not exclusive to Colchester) being actively managed.

**Time** – the majority of projects are currently expected to be delivered in line with timebox plans.

**Cost** - Spend v budget £3.8m (on track). Part of Colchester's 2023-24 c£8m DLUHC payment (£287k) due in April. The balance is expected in June. Timing of funding is linked to overall RAG rating in monitoring returns. Management of near proximity cost risks is important. DLUHC reassure that any payment issues will be discussed / explained.

**Monitoring** – Next DLUHC return due June 2023 (Oct 22-Mar 23 reporting period). Second Line of Defence deep dive also being managed. Working closely with S151.

### City Centre Master Plan and W Levelling Up Programme update

- Masterplan and St Botolph's changes out to public consultation in June. This will include:
  - 6-week digital based consultation
  - In-person drop-in sessions

- Work underway to bring the detailed programmes for each strand together to identify synergies and avoid clashes

### Project Spotlight Heart of Greenstead Community Hub

#### **Community Hub:**

- Architect tender is nearing completion.
- Architect interviews were held on 26 April 2023
- 3 members of the Community Taskforce joined the interview selection panel alongside representatives from CCC, NHS and Amphora Trading.
- Architects were asked to present on how they would engage with the community and ensure residents are able to feed into the design process.
- The architect contract is due to be awarded on 22 May 2023.

#### **Essex Pedal Power:**

- Formal application process to go live on 10 May 2023.
- First Cycle training day will be on 20 May 2023.
- First bike giveaway to take place on 17 June 2023.
- All staff now in post, including coordinator, mechanic, etc.

#### Liveable Neighbourhoods:

- The blueprint designs are still being worked on, with a view to a bid to the Active Travel Fund in summer 2024.
- In the interim period, several quick-wins will be implemented to introduce residents to the concept of liveable neighbourhood, including speeds reduction measures.
