- The application **must** be accompanied by an **original full birth certificate** (not a photocopy and one that shows parentage). The birth certificate will be returned to you by post, but can also be collected in person from the Town Hall, Colchester or in the instance where the applicant is resident outside of the United Kingdom, at the ceremony.
- If the applicant is married or previously married and has changed name as a result, the application must also be accompanied by an **original marriage certificate** (or other relevant documents). The certificate will be returned to you as details above.
- The details relating to the relative that you are claiming through must match exactly the information held in the Admissions of Freemen Book. A copy of this book is available for inspection by prior arrangement, at the Town Hall, High Street, Colchester CO1 1PJ. Telephone (01206) 282206.
- The space available on the certificate for information relating to your current occupation is limited, we advise that job titles and descriptions are kept as short as possible. Please ensure that all information including spelling of names is correct, as this is reproduced on the certificate and entered into the Admissions of Freemen Book.
