









4. The property size (no. bedrooms) needed by the highest-need households: Priority band A to C only: This is a decrease of 88 households bands A-C compared to April 22.





5. Average waiting times in months for a home in the City of Colchester: Average waiting time in months for general needs lets which occured 1st April 22 - 31st March 23 (bands A-C only). No lets were made to Band C applicants for either 3 bed or 4 bed properties. The overall average for 22-23 was 14 months compared to 21-22 overall average of 14 months.





7. Applicants housed by priority band: Comparing the number of people housed in Colchester between 1st April 22 and 31st March 23 by priority band.




