

PROGRESS TO DATE

- Scoping & Exploration Phase including governance structure completed (pre-August 2020)
- <u>Design Phase</u> nearing completion (August-October 2020) Town Investment Plan development aligned to a range of public engagement activity
- <u>Covid-19 response</u> incorporated into bid drafting (eg. CBC recovery programme (Council, Community, Customer, Economy) informing TIP project ideas
- External support and critical friend function ongoing Nichols/Arup
- Accelerated funding bid approved £1M (public realm projects)

Colchester was one of 101 towns invited to bid for £25m of Grant Funding, with criteria & scope set by government including: Geographic Area (Colchester urban area), demonstrating a 20 year+ vision for the Town (including quick wins), and investments must address known and well-evidenced challenges. Must spend by 2026.













TOWN DEAL INVESTMENT LOCATIONS
