Progress highlights

Town Centre & Gateways

St Nicholas Square (accelerated project), Works on site slightly delayed but materials ordered, due to **commence March 2023**

Essex County Hospital public realm contractor appointment slight delay to March, due to commence on site April 2023 (with completion by Spring 2024).

Jumbo North Essex Heritage Heritage Lottery Fund full application February 2023. Exploration of linking project to Balkerne Gate works ongoing (with no risk to either project).

Holy Trinity Church - planning permission granted, funded urgent repairs being carried out shortly. Heritage Lottery Fund EOI submitted, full application to follow. This activity de-risks the building for subsequent lease.





Progress highlights Heart of Greenstead

Essex Pedal Power launches Spring 2023

Plans for a Community Health and Wellbeing hub (including relocation of Hawthorn surgery) are progressing well (business case and appointment of architects), on track for delivery by **2026** as intended. Land acquisition options continue to be explored.

Digital Connectivity

Digital Skills Hub works should complete Spring 2023.

5G tourism creative use case agreed - tender for technical products to be issued February Digital Working Hub Queen Street: final stages of demolition now underway, archaeology commencing now, tender for construction phase to be issued February.

Transformed Youth Facilities

Contractor approach for the renovation of the Townhouse has been agreed, with detailed delivery plan work underway – completion target Spring 2024. Upgrade to Stanway and Highwoods Youth Centres is expected to be completed by Summer 2023.

Physical Connectivity

Town Centre to Greenstead and University (LCWIP 4) walking and cycling route – public consultation on prioritised route sections completed (High St / East Hill), on track for **completion late 2023.** Responding to feedback by flexing High Street / East Hill investment and exploring additional ATF funding. Full route on track to be completed by 2026.

Digi Hub ACL Colchester

Project Overview

- To redevelop the current gym building at ACL Colchester to create a digital skills hub and community space.
- The facility will support training, development, provide digital access and provide space for community activities.
- The project will, where possible use sustainable materials and energy sources.
- This dedicated and supportive space in the heart of the community, will enable skills development, create new opportunities, reduce barriers to education and jobs and improve both self and digital confidence.



Current layout


The space is currently split into three zones:

- IT Suite. Includes one disabled toilet and a small office.
- Main Hall Area. Includes one large storage cupboard and access to the kitchen
- Reception area. Includes, male, female and disabled toilets, storage cupboard and the kitchen









Planned Works

- Create one high spec IT suite
- Refurbish the main hall into one large space with partitioning to create two spaces if required
- Additional storage built in with fully accessible access and egress
- All toilets to be refitted and refurbished
- High-end reception/café/chill out area
- A-rated energy systems including ground source heat pump and solar panels
- New garden areas and EV charging points

Progress to date

- Work started 6th Feb
- Planning a soft launch over the summer
- Big launch for start of the 2023/24 Academic Year
- Comms plan and engagement activity now starting


