
How to use the Fixed Digital Access Points Interactive Map

By pressing the icon with a double pointed diagonal arrow on the lower righthand side of the map, this will open the map in full screen mode. Once you have finished press the diagonal arrow again and this will take you back to the original page.



If you would like to share the map locations with anyone or to send to another device press the share button which resembles a 3D arrow in a box and follow the instructions by selecting which image you wish to share the map by. Each image represents a sharing platform.



To zoom into the map, you can either use the wheel in the middle of your mouse (if you are using a mouse) or you can use the + or – buttons that you can see at the top right of the map.

At the top of the page there are some boxes and coloured circles, this allows you to be more selective with what you want to view:



Access Points – Where the Fixed Digital Access Points (FDAPs) are located.

Drop-Ins – Where we host in person drop-in sessions.

Older Person – Schemes where there are FDAPs located.

Surgery – GP Practices that have FDAPs located.

Colchester – Colchester area only

Tendring – Tendring area only

By selecting any of these boxes it will populate information relevant to that chosen box, to remove that selection press the box again. For example, if you want to see Drop-Ins in Colchester you will select the Drop-in and Colchester boxes and then the map will show where these are located via the coloured circles that populate. If you want to see everything you will not select any boxes.

When the map has been populated with the information you wish to view, dependent on the device you are using either hover your mouse or press your finger over any of the circles and a small black box will appear detailing the location and postcode of this access point.

Each coloured circle represents a different type of venue where the FDAPs are located.

Pink: Various in-person drop in and group sessions

Dark Blue: Surgeries/GP Practices

Turquoise: All other locations

Red: Older Person Sheltered Schemes
